Dear Students,

Pasco High School's Homecoming Dance will be held in the Dr. Donald McBath Activity Center on October 21st, 2016 at 8 p.m. We want everyone to have a wonderful and memorable evening so we ask that all participants wear formal attire and be appropriate and respectful in their behavior and actions throughout the night.

The following dress code rules for students apply during Homecoming:

Girls: Formal dresses/outfits must be modest at all times. They must not show any skin higher than 4" above the knee during any kind of movement throughout the evening (walking, standing, sitting, dancing, etc) and must not have slits higher than 4" above the knee, or any other immodest features. They must not show cleavage or any abdomen skin. However, spaghetti straps and sleeveless dresses are OK as long as they meet the rules above. In addition, no sneakers, tennis shoes or any kind of flip-flops are allowed.

Guys: Collared dress shirts and dress pants are required. Shirts must be tucked into pants appropriately, pants must not be sagging but be fitted securely around the waist, undergarments must not be visible, shorts and blue jeans are not allowed, nor any other inappropriate articles of clothing. In addition, no sneakers, tennis shoes or any kind of flip-flops are allowed.

All: If students show up to the dance out of dress code, they will be dealt with discretely and asked to correct the problem before they are allowed to enter the dance area.

The following rules apply for all students:

- **Ineligibility will be enforced for this school function.** If a student is already ineligible or becomes ineligible after purchasing a ticket, he or she will not be allowed to attend the Homecoming.
- Any students who are dancing inappropriately or who are out-of-control in their behavior or actions will be asked to leave the Homecoming and will not be allowed to return.
- There are **NO REFUNDS** for Homecoming tickets regardless of the reason why the student was not allowed to participate in the dance.

Students may pay for a guest to accompany them to Homecoming who does not attend PHS if they bring a copy of his/her driver's license or school ID, he/she does not violate the ineligibility list if he/she is a student at another school, and as long as he/she is not the age of 21 on or before October 21, 2016. A guest form must be completed. **Middle school students are not permitted to attend the homecoming dance.**

Thank you all very much in advance for observing the dance rules. We hope you enjoy Pasco High's 2016 Homecoming Dance!
