REQUIREMENTS FOR FBLA MEMBERS TO GAIN FULL BENEFITS

UNDERCLASSMEN (FIRST TIME OR RETURNING)

- Open to all club meetings. In the two-month time frame that we plan and prepare for district competitions, only members who are competing will be allowed to attend meetings.
- You must chose *two* volunteer opportunities to participate in. Members who meet this requirement will receive an award at our end-of-the-year banquet.

SENIORS (FIRST TIME OR RETURNING)

- In order to receive your cord for graduation, you must attend all mandatory meetings, and choose one event to compete in at districts, and participate in at least *one* volunteer opportunity.
- Members who meet all of these requirements will receive an award at our end-of-the-year banquet.
