Official Rules



Thank you for participating in the talent show process! Please read through the entire page and sign your name. **You must be ON-TRACK to perform!**

- 1 It is required that **all** of the members of each act be enrolled at Pasco High School. Attendance at the show is open to the public with a paid ticket.
- 2 A **maximum** of 8 individuals are eligible to perform in each act unless an exception is given. **Only** those listed on the application are eligible to perform. Once the entry form is submitted with your fee (\$10 for the first person and \$5 for each additional person performing in your group), no name changes, additions/subtractions, or substitutions will be permitted without special permission. **No changes will be permitted after the deadline of October 12, 2018**
- 3 An individual may perform in up to two acts as long as they are in different performance categories.
- 4 **Video audition submissions** must be completed and submitted with your application. Please send your videos to
- 5 A **mandatory** rehearsal will be held on Monday, November 12, 2018 @6pm.
- 6 The Talent Show will be held on Tuesday, November 13, 2018 from 7-9pm. All **performers are expected to arrive at 6pm** to prepare for their performance. Only the acts that have been selected will be eligible to perform for the show on this day. Entries that change music, costuming, and/or movement will be disqualified. **Your performance must be what you have submitted for your video audition piece.**
- 7 The application fee is \$10 for the first person and \$5 for each additional person performing in your group (**nonrefundable**)
- 8 Basic sound equipment will be available for performers. However, no special lighting or special effects (such as smoke machines, special scenery, etc.) may be used. Please list all technical needs on the application form provided. If it is not listed, you cannot expect it to be provided for your performance.
- 9 Each solo/duet act is limited to 3 minutes of actual performance time. Each group act is limited to 5 minutes of actual performance time and 3 minutes of setup and break down time combined. If a performer uses more than 5 minutes in the performance time, a deduction of 1 point for every 30 seconds will be assessed in the overall rating score.
- 10 All performances should be in good taste and school appropriate. Acts containing music, lyrics, gestures, costumes, or material that the judges consider to be rude or offensive may have points deducted or be disqualified.
- 11 Judges will base their evaluation in the following categories for both the audition and the final show: 1. Showmanship, 2. Creativity, 3. Content, and 4. Quality of ACT
- 12 The decisions of the judges are final.
- 13 Those acts selected for the final show will be judged on the same rating scale with the same criteria as the auditions.

- 14 The judges will be selected and will represent the members of the community in addition to alumni and staff.
- 15 The judges will determine the winners in each category (solo/duet and group) first, second, and third place awards.
- 16 Applicants must arrive on time for the dress rehearsal on Tuesday, November 6, 2018 at 6pm. And for the evening of the Talent show. Any contestant arriving late without prior approval may be disqualified from performing.
- 17 PHS has the sole authority to disqualify any contestant during any level of the contest for failure to comply with the rules and regulations stated above.
