Dear Students,

Pasco High School's 2019 Prom will be held at the Florida Aquarium on April 13th, 2019 from 7 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. We want everyone to have a wonderful and memorable evening so we ask that all participants wear formal attire and be appropriate and respectful in their behavior and actions throughout the night.

The following dress code rules for students apply during Prom:

Formal dresses/outfits must be modest at all times. They must not show any skin higher than 4" above the knee during any kind of movement throughout the evening (walking, standing, sitting, dancing, etc) and must not have slits higher than 4" above the knee, or any other immodest features. Spaghetti straps and sleeveless dresses are OK as long as they meet the rules above. In addition, no sneakers, tennis shoes or any kind of flip-flops are allowed. (The outfit may not be made of see-through material).

Collared dress shirts and dress pants are required. Shirts must be tucked into pants appropriately, pants must not be sagging but be fitted securely around the waist, undergarments must not be visible, shorts and blue jeans are not allowed, nor any other inappropriate articles of clothing. In addition, no athletic shoes/sneakers (i.e. Nikes, Adidas, ect.), skate shoes (i.e. Vans, Airwalks, ect.) or workboots will not be permitted. (A tie and jacket is strongly recommended)

Dress Code for Both Young Men and Young Women: students dressed inappropriately will be turned away at the door. Students will not be admitted wearing cargo pants, sneakers, jeans/denim, khakis (or other casual pants), t-shirts, torn clothing, chains/spikes, sexually implicit or explicit clothes, shorts, hats and head coverings, bandanas, or items referencing tobacco or alcohol products. Adjustments made at the door or during the dance (including pinning, the addition of a jacket, the addition of a body suit, etc.) will not be accepted as solutions for violations of the dress code. The principal's/designee's decisions is FINAL.

The following rules apply for all students:

- **On track will be enforced for this school function.** If a student is not on track, he or she will not be allowed to attend the dance.
- Any students who are dancing inappropriately or who are out-of-control in their behavior or actions will be asked to leave the dance and will not be allowed to return. *The Pasco County School Board Code of Student Conduct regulation and Pasco High School Rules will be enforced during Prom.*
- There are **NO REFUNDS** for Prom tickets regardless of the reason why the student was not allowed to participate in the dance.

Students may pay for a guest to accompany them to Prom who does not attend PHS if they bring a copy of his/her driver's license or school ID, he/she does not violate the ineligibility list if he/she is a student at another school, and as long as he/she is not the age of 21 on or before April 13, 2019. A guest form must be completed AND approved in advance by Admin by Friday, March 29th, 2019 **Middle school students are not permitted to attend Prom.**
